




EXTENSION OF MOU RELATIVE TO PLANNING AND IMPLEMENTING
CERTAIN UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE PROGRAMS
ON INDIAN LANDS

On November 6, 2019, the following agencies United State Department of Interior (DOI), Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA); United States Department of Agriculture Farm Production and Conservation (USDA-FPAC), Farm Service Agency (FSA), and Natural Resources Conservation Service (NRCS) entered into a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) titled, “MOU Relative to Planning and Implementing Certain United States Department of Agriculture Programs on Indian Lands.” Section V-Mutually Agreed and Understood, Item 5 states “This MOU may be extended or modified upon written request of any of the agencies and the subsequent written concurrence of the other(s).”

This document, signed by all parties, serves as mutually agreed upon consent to extend this MOU for a period of five (5) years beyond its original expiration of November 6, 2024. BIA, USDA-FPAC, FSA, and NRCS retain all rights to terminate its participation in this MOU with a sixty (60)-day written notice to the other(s).
